| Words and terms to know | Do I know this word? | Meaning |
|-------------------------|--------------------------|---|
| job | <input type="checkbox"/> | the work that you do in exchange for money |
| career | <input type="checkbox"/> | a profession or trade that you are trained for and which you do during your working life |
| interest | <input type="checkbox"/> | an activity or subject that you like to know about |
| hobby | <input type="checkbox"/> | an activity that you do for enjoyment such as reading |
| household chore | <input type="checkbox"/> | an activity you do to help around the house such as mowing the lawn |
| employability | <input type="checkbox"/> | the skills, knowledge, and values you need to be job-ready |
| strength | <input type="checkbox"/> | something that you are good at |
| challenge | <input type="checkbox"/> | something that is difficult but may still be achievable for you |
| skill | <input type="checkbox"/> | tasks that you can do because you have experience or training, for example: cooking, teamwork, or report-writing |
| sensory | <input type="checkbox"/> | ways in which people are different from each other |
| individual differences | <input type="checkbox"/> | changes to a workplace or a work-role to make sure that someone with a disability can do their job |
| workplace adjustments | <input type="checkbox"/> | changes to a learning environment, method of learning or the way learning is assessed to make sure that someone with a disability is treated fairly |
| learning accommodations | <input type="checkbox"/> | offer to work without being paid |
| volunteering | <input type="checkbox"/> | working in exchange for money |
| earn | <input type="checkbox"/> | ways in which people are different from each other |
