### For all work experience levels

myWAY Employability encourages students to maintain a journal before, during, and after their work experience.

We have provided some writing prompts for you to provide to students who need this kind of support with writing.

For some students, a photographic diary may be a good option.

Print the second page of the student's journal "During work experience" for each day that the student attends work experience.

We recommend that you read your student's work experience journal each week to track your student's progress.

# Scaffolding

Most of our student worksheets have at least two versions. Each version is differentiated according to the level of scaffolding it provides.



1 Hand = least amount of scaffolding



2 Hand = moderate scaffolding

#### **Scaffolding** may refer to:

- Level of language used on the sheet
- Use of visual supports
- Structure by way of tick boxes etc.
- Or a combination of these.
